# **Professional Background**

Joanna's professional career began as a Rotational Occupational Therapist at the Royal Berkshire Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust. She progressed to Senior Occupational Therapist, working within Sherwood Forest Hospital NHS Foundation Trust's Acute Medicine and Surgery team. Within this role, she delivered assessment and intervention across 12 wards, including Neurology and Stroke. She also attended case conferences for palliative care patients and contributed to training and service development activities. Between 2008 and 2010, Joanna operated as a Research Therapist at the University of Nottingham, on a randomised control trial of a neuropsychological approach to dressing problems in people following stroke. Alongside this role she completed her MPhil degree. She subsequently worked on a major multi-centre phase III trial of an occupational therapy intervention for care home residents with stroke whilst completing her PhD. Joanna also conducted a national survey study of six-month reviews and follow-up of long-term unmet needs after stroke for the Global Stroke Advisory Panel and contributed to the Royal College of Physician's National Clinical Guidelines for Stroke. Between 2014 and 2018, Joanna was promoted to Senior Research Fellow and successfully led an NIHR funded clinical trial (ESCAPS study) as Chief Investigator. She was also involved in research across the brain injury research portfolio and supervised several PhD students. Joanna was the Research and Development Officer for the National Executive Committee of the Royal College of Occupational Therapists Specialist Section for Neurological Practice and subsequently was elected a member of Council for the Society for Research in Rehabilitation. Since 2018, Joanna has worked as a Rehabilitation Case Manager, in addition holding the position of Clinical Lead since 2022. Within this capacity, she has managed a complex caseload of clients recovering from catastrophic poly-trauma injuries. As Clinical Lead, she is accountable for managing a team of case managers, including training and safeguarding activities.
